We are taking a field trip to the nursery at the invitation of member Evan McCrory. If you've ever gone to any of the many art or crafts festivals in Central Florida and have seen a booth with some of most spectacular Bromeliads in bloom, you've almost certainly seen McCrory's booth. Their plants are real showstoppers with lots of Guzmanias, Vrieseas and Aechmeas in bloom and very colorful Neoregelias!

For this field trip, we can use our own cars since there is lots of parking available at the nursery.
