Information for SBBA sellers and exhibitors from show chairman Ted Johnson:

Dual Labels for plant sales

SALES PLANTS

Bromeliads are preferred, but other plants are acceptable. Sale plants must be double tagged, with each tag having the price, name of the plant (if known), and your name or plant sale #. Donated plants are gladly accepted, but should be double tagged Print CLUB on the name side of the label for donated plants. Please bring bags and boxes so people have something to carry their purchases in. The split for sellers is 80/20% (Seller/SBBA)

Example of Plant Tags:

One side of tag:

T Johnson #350

And on the other side:

\$15.00 Neo. spectabilis variegata

General comments on the 8/10/24 Show

- 1-There is no judging in this show, so you don't need to worry about special BSI rules.
- 2- We're holding the show to share bromeliads we like with the general public. If you have a plant that you like, put it in the show. Others may like it also.
- 3- Please water your show and sale plants a few days BEFORE the show to allow the mix in the pot to partially dry and prevent puddles on the show and sale tables. Dump the water out of the plants the day before you bring them in to show or sell. LIGHTLY mist the leaf axils to supply some moisture for the one-day show.
- 4-Please have all show plants on the tables with entry tags filled out before the 10 AM show opening. Give yourself time to achieve this don't show up 10 minutes before 10 AM
- 5- We cannot serve food to the public in the PV Art Center, but you can bring your own lunch and eat it there. There is a refrigerator in the kitchen and a microwave oven available to you. Otherwise, there are restaurants on Silver Spur Road about 2-3 blocks away where you can buy your lunch or a sandwich.
- 6-The plant entry forms and the Exhibitor's List of Entries only require your name and the name of the plant(s).

At the information table near the Show/Sale entrance, there will be forms for prospective members to fill out. Please wear your SBBA badge, and if you see visitors, welcome them and

invite them to think about membership. At this point, the year is half over, so the usual \$10 dues per family (not per person) is only \$5. There will also be a signup sheet for visitors who just want to be informed of future SBBA plant shows/sales.

If you intend to display plants for the Show, please fill out identification tag(s). A set of 3 of these tags will be sent to each SBBA member as an attachment to the email you will receive with this newsletter. Look for the "Plant Entry Form" attachment to download and print. Another important attachment is "SBBA Exhibitor's List of Show Entries." This list helps Show organizers keep track of members' entries so that none are misplaced.
