SEMBS March – April 2022 Newsletter

It is with great sadness that we share news of the passing of two of our long-time members in recent weeks. On February 22, 2022, Jane Klosterman died after a lengthy illness. One week later on March 1, 2022, Andrea Gray lost her decades long battle with lupus. Their obituaries are included in the newsletter. Our condolences and prayers are with the families, and especially for George Klosterman and Gordon Gray.

Calendar Update for upcoming meetings:

March 2022- There will be no meeting held this month.

Saturday, April 9, 2022, at 2:00 PM using Google Meet. Details below. This is one week earlier than our typical meeting date due to the Easter holiday the following weekend. Indiana resident and member Kevin Patterson will share his knowledge and enthusiasm for growing bromeliads from seed in a virtual workshop. Kevin will detail all aspects of the process, from acquiring and producing seed, germination media and planting seed, lighting, and temperature. Examples will be shown of seedlings in



various stages of growth, which can be very helpful for other growers so that they can know what to

We will also have a brief discussion about our society's spring group order from Michael's Bromeliads and from Tillandsia International. It is not required that you be present



to participate in the order, though if you have any special order requests, or know how many "Grower's Choice" plants you would like, you can email Paul Wingert pcwingert@gmail.com with any lists. If you wish to explore Michael's full catalog, go to https://michaelsbromeliads.com choose the "Our Collections" tab from the

Home page. You are welcome to special order from the catalog. There aren't a ton of photos on Michael's web page, but there are fantastic internet resources if you google a species name or cultivar name. The BSI Species Database (newly released on March 16!!) and the BSI Cultivar Registry are two good places to research individual plants! If Michael has the requested item available, he typically offers a 25% discount from list price for our society order. Most of our society order is typically the "Grower's Choice" selections. You may order any number of plants at price points of \$5 or \$10. (Prices include shipping charges and MI state sales tax). Michael does a very nice job honoring general requests i.e., variegated or mini Neoregelias, hybrid Billbergias, spiny terrestrials, or an "eclectic mix" for those who wish to explore some of the oddball Bromeliad genera! For those who are particularly fond of Tillandsias, go the https://airplant.com website. Plants priced \$10 and above can be ordered individually. If anyone desires individual Tillandsias in the \$2-10 price range, please contact Paul to confirm that the required minimum will be ordered. For those who are looking for more information and pictures of some of the Tillandsias, there are some good resources online. The Facebook group "Planet Tillandsia" is a great place for absolute fanatics. If you search "Frank Messina" (owner of Tillandsia International) on Planet Tillandsia, it highlights all of Frank's posts and photos- a superior resource to the catalog on the airplant.com website! It's worth repeating that the BSI Species Database and the BSI Cultivar Registry are two good places to research individual plants!

Take note that the deadline for placing orders will be Saturday, April 30, 2022!



After graduating from Dearborn High school, she went onto attend 2 years of college at Bob Jones University, studying business administration. In the spring of 1966, Andrea met Gordon Gray, and they wed May 6, 1967, and went on to have 2 children, Christy, and Matthew.

Andrea was very active in church and in life. At Covenant Community Church, you could find her leading young women's bible study, Pioneer Girls side by side with her mother. She also was actively involved in the women's ministry, Winning Women. She and Gordon loved to bowl



and were in a bowling league for many years. She also had a passion for plants and flowers. That passion led her to attend Michigan State University to obtain her Master Gardner's Certification in 2007. Her passion and joy started with African violets and expanded into a full greenhouse of orchids, succulents, cacti, and other unique plants that she obtained along the way. She also held membership at the Michigan Bromeliad society and the Michigan Orchid Society. Her other passion was supporting others. When she was first diagnosed with Lupus in 1986, she immediately began researching Lupus, not only for herself but to also provide others with information and support, so they didn't feel alone. She volunteered leading support groups, running on-call hotlines from home, and doing whatever she could to help others dealing with Lupus.

Andrea enjoyed beauty in all things and was always determined to make the best of what God blessed her with. While we are at a loss without her, we have such peace and joy knowing that she is in the presence of Jesus and now home!

Andrea was predeceased by her father Richard, her mother Margaret, and her sister Lynda. Andrea is survived by her husband, Gordon, her children Christy and Matthew, daughter in law Melanie, and grandchildren Elsa and Mary. She is also survived by her brothers and sister, Roger, Pat, Dave, Rick, Phil, and Tim along with countless cousins, nieces, nephews, and friends.
