### 1005/10/11 CARIBBEAN SUNSET

(CRUENTA 'Sun King' X CATHERINE WILSON) One of our earliest & most popular hybrids. All 1005 CV's (except 2) make SHORT, STOLONIFEROUS 'WINGS', are EXCELLENT when HOT-GLUED TO DRIFTWOOD, and are ESPECIALLY WELL SUITED to growing as LARGE MULTIPLES, which play the short, robust STOLONS to best advantage. They can take VERY BRIGHT, NEARLY FULL SUNLIGHT, if properly conditioned, and have an UPRIGHT, VASE SHAPE. 'Coral Reef' 'Doubloon' & 'Curacao' CV's each vary slightly, have BROAD, HEAVILY TEXTURED, LIGHT YELLOW/GREEN LEAVES with HEART-SHAPED, BRIGHT PINK FINGERNAILS, overlaid in SUNSET COLORS of PINK AND ORANGE, & a variety of SPOTTING showing through the CONTRASTING UNDERLEAF COLOR. Particularly attractive when displayed at EYE LEVEL or HIGHER. (17.50). 'Planter's Punch' These CV's are similar to the above in all respects, except leaf color, which is a SOLID, CLEAR, PEACHY PINK, without spotting, reminiscent of the orange juice, red grenadine, & dark rum of its namesake; nice WINGS, BEST MOUNTED AS MULTIPLE. (17.50) 'Calypso' ★★★ These are EXCEPTIONAL CV'S, selected for their BRILLIANT, SATURATED ROSY-PINK color; they have HEAVY, WIDE leaves, and are not stolonif. or upright. (\$25.) 'Port O' Call' ★★★ This ONE-OF-A-KIND SuperClone, has an EXTREMELY INTENSE, RED/ORANGE LEAF MARGIN AND TIPPING, OVERLAI'D ON A LIGHTER ORANGE/PINK BASE LEAF COLOR, and is so intense in maturity it can easily be spotted all the way across the greenhouse. Leaves, while not especially full in number, are BROAD AND HEAVY, and LARGE OVERALL. RED MARGINS INTENSIFY as plant grows, and upon maturity, in good light, RED OVERLAY WILL EXTEND OVER HALFWAY DOWN THE LEAF. (\$50.)

### 1100 □ VOODOO

(ROYAL BURGUNDY 'Deser' X TAKEMURA PRINCEPS) All CV's of VOODOO are DEEP RED with SMALL, LIGHT SPOTTING, MEDIUM-TO-LARGE size, and EXCELLENT CONFORMATION influenced by the superior parents. 'Baron Samedi' in his black top hat and white-paint face, is the principal voodoo spirit, as this is the principal CV, with a very TakPrin Leafshape, various markings. 'Sirene' (The Mermaid) 'Veve' (The intricate design drawn on the floor to invoke the spirits), and 'Zandor' (The secret ritual of the Voodoo) are very full, darker, more conventional leaf shape. (All CV \$25)

### 1260 □ ISLANDS IN THE SUN

(MORRIS HENRY HOBBS X COMPACTA 'Rubra Marginata') One especially EXCELLENT FEATURE of COMPACTA is its ability to CROSS-BREED with NON-STOLON NEO'S and still put out stoloniferous 'WINGS', albeit somewhat shorter. This cross was named 'Islands In The Sun' for it was meant TO BE GROWN, not as individual plants, but as ISLAND MULTIPLES and even as ASYMMETRICAL ARCHIPELAGOS (judges, take note). ALL have RED CENTERS, short WINGS, somewhat UPRIGHT shape. (All CV's 17.50) CV'S WITH PINK EDGING AND BLUSHING OVER PALE YELLOW/GREEN LEAVES: 'St.Vincent' 'St.Luc' CV'S WITH CLEAR, SOLID, DEEP PINK-TO-RED LEAFAGE: 'Barbados' 'Bimini' All have soft, compacta-esque foliage.

### 1308 □ HURRICANE ALLEY

(GRANDE 'Fantastic Gardens/QBT' X CORIACEA 'Kent's Best') 'English Harbour' 'Port Royal' DEEP, RICH CHOCOLATE/MAROON BARRING, WIDE LEAF

### 1250 □ FLAMINGO

(OH NO 'Very Cherry' X CRUENTA RUBRA 'Goliath') 'Flight Of Fancy' ★★★ A shocking 'FLAMINGO PINK' very ELECTRIC, on a SOFT, LARGE, WIDE LEAFED, VERY FULL LEAF PATTERN. Combination of excellent characteristics from both parents. (\$25.)

### 2005 □ COCONUT GROVE

(NEOREGELIA AMPULLACEA HYB. #334 X CRYPTANTHUS FOSTERIANUS) A good bet for the BIGENERICS DIVISION OF SHOWS, this SMALL, STOLONIFEROUS combination has SQUAT, FAT LEAVES, a DOMINANT NEO-LOOK, marked with SPOTS & traces of BARRING. (\$35.) 'Coco Loc'

### 1072 □ TROPICANA

(OH NO 'Very Cherry' X CAROLINAE 'Lili') 'Caribe' Sundrenched days of beachcombing through deserted coves inspire this cross which has the CORAL PINK color and glossy texture of a freshly discovered seashell, bright red tips (\$10).

### 1207 □ WINDWARD PASSAGE

(MELANODONTA HYBRID #422 X CONCENTRICA 'Big Blue') 'Azure Tides' ★★★ This EXCEPTIONAL CV, first to bloom, has a DEEP, RICH, MELANODONTA PURPLE CUP, and VERY WIDE OVERALL LEAFAGE. It was bred onward in '87 to EMERAL CITY, REFLECTIONS, & KINGDOM OF PERSIA, and differs significantly from other CV's of this cross.

### 1239 □ MARTINIQUE

((TRISTIS X MARIE)) X MEYENDORFFI) 'Ile De France' One of our best plants of ORANGE-TO-RED leaf color, contrasting red cup (\$17.50)

### 1321 □ CARIVALE

(TAKEMURA PRINCEPS X MAGIC CUP OF PAINTS) All CV's of this cross have been EXCELLENT, and most have remained very small and compact, with pink barring and heart-tipped leaves, and will be available after the Great Bloom Of '83. One LARGE, UNUSUAL cultivar 'Masks Off At Midnight' ★★★ bloomed this past year, and a FEW are now available. HEAVY TEXTURE & TAKPRINCEPS LEAF SHAPE with BRONZE/ORANGE color to the leafage and LIGHT RED SPECKS, plus a BRILLIANT RED CUP (\$35.)

- 1243 □ SLAVE'S CHALICE** (JOHANNIS RUBRA X ((TRISTIS X HARIE))~~PALE GREEN/YELLOW~~ Named for a HAND CRAFTED SILVER CHALICE, presented to the 'Cathedral Of Montserrat' on the British Commonwealth Island, by the slaves, to commemorate their emancipation in the 1800's, this CV matches a special double-exposure photo, which is principal to 'JOURNEY TO THE RAINBOW'S END'. Selected for its RICH, DARK MAROON /BLACKISH JOHANNIS-GENE-INFLUENCED LEAFAGE, and GLOSSY TEXTURE, the black chalice stays SMALL, GOOD COHESION, 501.
- 1320 □ JAMAICA** (LADY RACINE 'Bromel-La' X PRINCEPS 'Indigo')~~PALE GREEN/YELLOW~~ The INDIGO/PURPLE of the PRINCEPS CUP has transmitted itself into the LEAFAGE AND CUP of the JAMAICA CV's., a SOFT, ROMANTIC TONAL RANGE, befitting its namesake, one of the world's most exotic Islands. MULTI-LAIVED FULLNESS, to which Lady Racine has ADDED SIZE. Various CV's, (all 525.) 'Kingston' 'Negril' 'Port Antonio' 'Montego Bay'.

- 1025 □ FLAMBOYANT** (COMPACTA 'Crown Prince' X ((FOSTERIANA X SPECTABILIS))~~PALE GREEN/YELLOW~~ 'Royal Poinciana' 'Poinciana June' is a famous Nassau celebration, when the Island is afire with the red and gold trees--this same theme is picked up in this BRIGHT RED CV with YELLOWISH SPOTS, and the THIN, SPINELESS LEAF OF COMPACTA. Spectabilis seems to have remained dormant. (S. 10.)

- 1318 □ ROSE HALL** (FAIRY PAINT 'New Orleans' X DECORA 'Concentrica By Princeps')~~PALE GREEN/YELLOW~~ 'Anne Palmer' Named for the EVIL MISTRESS of the famed ROSE HALL PLANTATION outside Montego Bay, and whose ghost reputedly still roams the cane fields in the moonlight, this special CV has WIDE LEAVES, and an UNUSUAL CUP PATTERN OF STRIKING, IRREGULAR SPOTTING AGAINST PINK 'FAIRY PT' BKG. (525)
