CULTURE OF BROMELIADS

The media in which Bromeliads are successfully grown varies primarily with the amount of water the plant receives. One must keep in mind, however, that Bromeliads do not appreciate excessive water. This is most harmful when the base of the plant and its root zone are kept too wet. It follows, therefore, that if a Bromeliad is grown out-of-doors in a region of heavy rainfall more drainage would be required of the potting media. Likewise, if the plant is grown inside your house, or in a cool area which is very dry, less drainage would be required. The amount of attention, and therefore the amount of water your plant receives on a regular basis will also determine the amount of drainage in the potting mixture. At our nursery, under controlled greenhouse conditions, we recommend and utilize the following:

- a) 3 parts of 3/8" to 1/2" bark (fir or redwood, NOT pine)
- b) 1 part COARSE peat moss (German or Canadian-Manitoba or Quebec)
- c) 1 tbs. superphosphate (0-20-0)
- d) 1 tbs. slow release fertilizer (15-15-15)
- e) Dolomite to reach a Ph of 6.0 (approximately 1-2 tbs.)

NOTE: The amount of Dolomite depends upon the alkalinity (Ph) of your local water. Rain water is best, and water high in Calcium or other salts is undesirable.

It is VERY IMPORTANT to wet the mix thoroughly. Any roots which come into contact with a dry mixture will die immediately. Likewise, it is equally important to be certain that the plant is NOT MOVING in the media. Continuous movement kills any new root growth and injures the basal part of the Bromeliad. Finally, it is very important to change the potting media on a yearly basis. In areas of excessive rainfall, this may be necessary every six months as the mixture decomposes into a sludge when it's constantly wet.

Excessive moisture not only drowns the root ball, but also encourages the growth of detrimental fungi and bacteria. If a softening of the lower leaves or a discoloration of the central leaves occurs, it's very likely that a fungus infestation is present. Another indicator is a putrid odor, especially in the vase of the Bromeliad. When this occurs (if it's not already too late), one should remove the plant from the potting media and remove all of the dead leaves and roots. It may be necessary to discard the entire root ball if it appears to hold too much water. When the plant becomes dry, then it's best to apply a fungicide, i.e. Truban or Captan. **DO NOT APPLY** Benlate as it stunts the growth of Bromeliads. Finally, repot the plant in fresh media and apply water sparingly for several weeks until new roots appear.

Fertilization of Bromeliads is a very controversial subject. When a plant is grown under ideal conditions with adequate sunshine and temperatures above 50° F., only then will it be able to absorb nutrients for its growth. Too much fertilizer produces plants with very narrow grass-like leaves, especially if the fertilizer is high in the element Nitrogen. If it's desirable to produce plants with broad compact leaves and brilliant colors other than green, then one should not fertilize your Bromeliad (specifically the genus *Neoregelia*) until **AFTER** it flowers. Plants in the other Genera (especially *Vriesias* and *Guzmanias*) appreciate fertilizer throughout their growing stages. As a general all-purpose fertilizer, we recommend a formulation in the ratio of 1-2-2 (Nitrogen-Phosphorus-Potassium; NPK). We **DO NOT RECOMMEND** using Fish Emulsion because it contains too much Nitrogen. It's important not to apply the fertilizer in strengths so strong as to burn the leaves (the spineless Bromeliads are the most sensitive). We recommend a dilute application of approximately ½ strength to avoid damaging your plants.

Pest control is best achieved by purchasing plants from certified nurseries. If problems do arise, we recommend dipping the entire plant into a prescribed insecticide. Most insecticides kill effectively upon contact and systemic insecticides are not always absorbed by Bromeliads. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** to drain any residue from inside the cup of the Bromeliad to avoid chemical burning. At our nursery, we follow the treatment as prescribed by the USDA. A combination of Malation and Sevin (**WETTABLE POWDERS** only) is applied twice yearly as a preventative measure. **NEVER USE "SPREADER STICKERS"** as they contain an agent which severely burns the foliage. On certain insects, i.e. scale, it may be necessary to repeat the dipping application 10 days later.

Frequently it is asked, "At what time do I remove the pup?" At our nursery we **STRONGLY RECOMMEND** that the young plant have at least a few roots present to avoid the disappointments of either no growth at all or dormancy for a period of many months. If the plant has several sets of leaves and appears to be stocky, problems should not result. It's not necessary to treat the young offset with a rooting hormone. Many growers also allow the plant to "harden off" for several days, but this is usually not necessary. We have found that to initiate growth, repeated applications of a fertilizer which is high in

Phosphorous is beneficial to the young plant. Of course, application of bottom heat is extremely beneficial if available.
