This little catalog lists more than 1300 decorative House plants and greenhouse Exotics. For almost a century, Roehrs Exotic Nurseries have been known as pioneer collectors and growers in America, and we have endeavored to maintain one of the best collections, including the more unusual plants for indoor use available to the public.

Because of the many growth stages that may be available at any given time in our greenhouses, prices listed are for sizes most generally on hand, but even these are not available at all times, owing to limited mother stock, and orders can be filled only subject to supply. If you are looking for any special size, write us. We have here a list covering larger and specimen decorative plants, but these would be difficult to ship beyond the New York Metropolitan area.

We are primarily wholesale growers, with an active Department for Interior Landscaping and Maintenance. We publish this rather plain catalog on Exotic plants for the convenience of plant lovers and collectors that may be looking for unusual plants, but it is primarily a long list of names without descriptive text.

Almost all plants listed here are pictured and described together with a code to care, in our hand-book **EXOTIC PLANTS ILLUSTRATED**, picturing 1400 plants; and more exhaustively, the Pictorial Cyclo-pedia **EXOTICA 3**, with 12,000 illustrations and comprehensive text. See page 16 for listings of these books.

SIZES indicated are relative and determined by growth habit:

SMALL plants generally are offshoots, divisions or rooted cuttings from 2 1/4" or 3" pots.

MEDIUM size are more matured plants, usually 4" or 5" pots.

LARGE size will be good sized plants and may be in 5", 6", 7" or 8" pots, or larger.

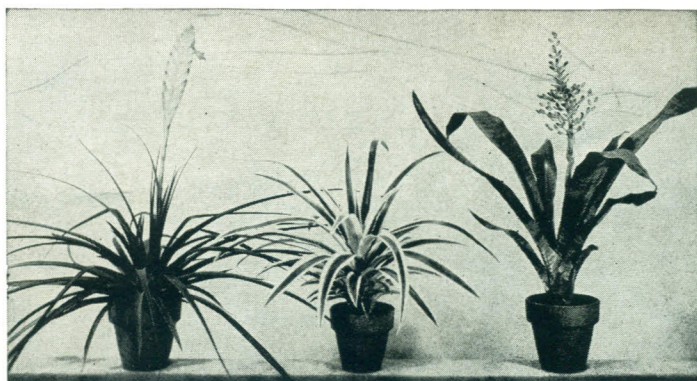
